

# Travelling to the venue

Directions from the main points of arrival are detailed below. Note that the public transport journey planner from any other London location can be found at [www.tfl.gov.uk](http://www.tfl.gov.uk).

There will be a free shuttle bus available from East Croydon station to the hotel. If you can't spot us, please text or call the team on +44 (0) 7971 320 196.

If needed, transport tickets/oyster cards to East Croydon station, which is in zone 5, can be purchased from any London Underground or mainline station – there is no need for separate underground and mainline tickets. Oysters can be used as 'pay as you go' smartcards, and are the cheapest and easiest option for all travel within zones 1 – 6 of London. Note that you will need to provide a £5 deposit when you first purchase one.

Please be aware that there will be road closures in London and Surrey on 10 August due to the Prudential RideLondon weekend festival of cycling. This is not expected to affect tube and rail transport, just buses and cars.

There are planned engineering works on the London Underground on the weekends of 9/10 August and 16/17 August. This is not expected to impact routes to and from the venue, but if you are planning to do some sightseeing, you may wish to check your journey before you travel at [www.tfl.gov.uk](http://www.tfl.gov.uk).

## Gatwick

For those who have provided their flight details, we will meet you on arrival as you exit the baggage hall. If you can't spot us, please wait near this exit. Note that there may be flights landing at similar times at the two separate terminals, in which case we may take a few minutes to reach you. If you are waiting for long, please text or call the team on +44 (0) 7971 320 196.

From Gatwick, we will provide you with a ticket for the train to East Croydon station, where a shuttle bus will then transport you to the hotel.

## Heathrow

If you are arriving on 10 August AND have provided your flight details, please make your way to the Heathrow Central Bus Station near terminals 1 – 3. If you arrive at terminals 4 or 5, please use the Heathrow Express train (free of charge) to transfer to terminals 1 – 3, where you should follow the signs to the bus station (opposite the entrance to the underground). We will meet you as you enter the Heathrow Central Bus Station. If you can't spot us, please wait near Caffe Nero. If you are waiting for long, please text or call the team on +44 (0) 7971 320 196.

You will be provided with a ticket and directions for transit to East Croydon station, where a shuttle bus will then transport you to the hotel.

If you are not arriving on 10 August, please refer to [www.tfl.gov.uk](http://www.tfl.gov.uk) for the best transport route to East Croydon station for your time of arrival. Routes can include the following:

- X26 bus to East Croydon station from Heathrow Central Bus Station near terminals 1 – 3 (1 hr 35 mins). Note that you can transfer from terminals 4 or 5 to 1 – 3 using the Heathrow Express train free of charge. Please then follow the signs to the bus station (opposite the entrance to the underground), where you will need to buy a ticket/oyster card before boarding the bus. At £1.45 on an oyster, this is the cheapest route.
- If you arrive at terminals 4 or 5, the Piccadilly underground line can take you to Hatton Cross Station (6 mins), where you can also catch the X26 bus to East Croydon station (1 hr 15 mins)
- Piccadilly underground line to Hammersmith (36 mins); District underground line to Victoria (14 mins); mainline train to East Croydon (16 mins)
- Heathrow Express train to Paddington (23 mins with an additional surcharge of c£20); Circle underground line to Victoria station (14 mins); mainline train to East Croydon (16 mins)

Whilst en route, please text or call the team on +44 (0) 7971 320 196 to advise the time and departure point of the mainline train you have caught so that we can arrange for the shuttle bus to collect you from East Croydon station.

For those who prefer to either catch a taxi or hire a car, please note that the journey from Heathrow to Croydon will generally take about an hour. The estimated average fare for a cab is £100 - £160.



Please refer to [www.tfl.gov.uk](http://www.tfl.gov.uk) for your best train times to East Croydon station.

From the airport, please follow the signs to the shuttle bus (5 mins) to Luton Airport Parkway station. Note that this is free if you have a train ticket, so we would suggest you buy either a single or open return ticket from within the airport.

From the station, please catch a train to East Croydon station (direction: Brighton). The train will take just over an hour, usually running 4 times each hour.

Whilst en route, please text or call the team on +44 (0) 7971 320 196 to advise the time and departure point of the mainline train you have caught so that we can arrange for the shuttle bus to collect you from East Croydon station.

For those who prefer to either catch a taxi or hire a car, please note that the journey from Luton to Croydon will generally take about an hour and 20 minutes. The estimated average fare for a cab is £160 - £280.



Please refer to [www.tfl.gov.uk](http://www.tfl.gov.uk) for your best train times to East Croydon station.

The recommended route is to catch a train from Stansted Airport Rail Station to Tottenham Hale (33 mins, direction: London Liverpool Street). Transfer to the tube, catching the Victoria underground line to Victoria station (19 mins). Transfer back to mainline rail for a train to East Croydon station (15 mins, direction: Littlehampton, Ore, Southampton or Portsmouth).

Whilst en route, please text or call the team on +44 (0) 7971 320 196 to advise the time and departure point of the mainline train you have caught so that we can arrange for the shuttle bus to collect you from East Croydon station.

For those who prefer to either catch a taxi or hire a car, please note that the journey from Stansted to Croydon will generally take about an hour and 15 minutes. The estimated average fare for a cab is £170 - £230.



Please refer to [www.tfl.gov.uk](http://www.tfl.gov.uk) for your best train times to East Croydon station.

Please catch the DLR (Docklands Light Railway, direction: Stratford International, Bank) to Canning Town Station (7 mins), where you should go downstairs to catch the Jubilee underground line to London Bridge station (11 mins). Transfer to the mainline rail station for a train to East Croydon station (12 – 17 mins, direction: Horsham, Brighton).

Whilst en route, please text or call the team on +44 (0) 7971 320 196 to advise the time and departure point of the mainline train you have caught so that we can arrange for the shuttle bus to collect you from East Croydon station.

For those who prefer to either catch a taxi or hire a car, please note that the journey from London City Airport to Croydon will generally take about 45 minutes. The estimated average fare for a cab is £70 - £85.



Please refer to [www.tfl.gov.uk](http://www.tfl.gov.uk) for your best train times to East Croydon station.

Recommended route is to catch a mainline train from St Pancras station directly to East Croydon station (30 mins, direction: Brighton). Note that these trains usually run 4 times each hour.

Whilst en route, please text or call the team on +44 (0) 7971 320 196 to advise the time and departure point of the mainline train you have caught so that we can arrange for the shuttle bus to collect you from East Croydon station.

For those who prefer to either catch a taxi or hire a car, please note that the journey from St Pancras International to Croydon will generally take about 40 minutes. The estimated average fare for a cab is £50 - £65.
